A limited number of passport applications will be accepted as data capture alone takes 10-15 minutes per applicant. To streamline this, the Consulate requires passport applicants to submit documents and payment for pre-process by the Consulate at least 10 days before the outreach. This will allow time for data capture, and inform applicants by email of the time they are expected to show-up at the venue, reducing the waiting time. First-come-first- served for legalization of documents, notarization, authentication, report of marriage, report of birth and dual citizenship.
