

The provincial government has once again published a list of in-demand occupations that would allow interested applicants to immigrate faster than others via the regular express entry processing.


While the term "express entry" under the federal system is a misnomer and only applies to those who are given an invitation to apply, it seems that the provinces are playing a similar game by publishing in-demand occupation lists in order to attract the best and brightest to their territories.

As an added incentive, no job offer is required.

As well, there is no requirement that an applicant work in the field/occupation in which they are selected.

For example, if an applicant is selected based on their vast experience as an architect, there is
