The provincial government has once again published a list of in-demand occupations that would allow interested applicants to immigrate faster than others via the regular express entry processing.

While the term “express entry” under the federal system is a misnomer and only applies to those who are given an invitation to apply, it seems that the provinces are playing a similar game by publishing in-demand occupation lists in order to attract the best and brightest to their territories.

As an added incentive, no job offer is required.

As well, there is no requirement that an applicant work in the field/occupation in which they are selected.

For example, if an applicant is selected based on their vast experience as an architect, there is

no requirement that the applicant eventually work in that field.

For that reason, the latest option in immigrating to Canada is attractive to many.

However, to qualify an applicant must:

- **have a post-secondary diploma or degree**

- **proficiency in English**

- **optimal age is under 35 (over 35 still qualify but less points)**

- **government processing fee of \$300 and at least one year of work experience in one of the following 42 occupations in demand (more than one year will award more points):**

- **Electrical Engineers**

- **Industrial Engineers**

- **Computer Engineers**

- **Architects**

- **Land Surveyors**
